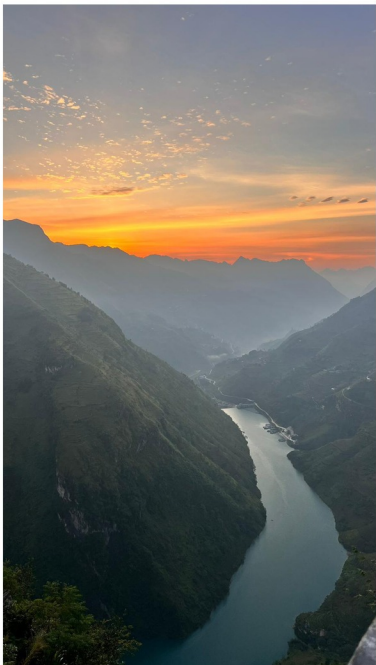

QUICK FACTS

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- Tour program **starts at 8.00am - finishes around 4.30pm** from Style Motorbikes (20 Hoang Huu Chuyen, Ha Giang City).
- The Jeep tours are **private tours** but can be mixed with the motorbike tours if some of the group want to be on motorbike.
- Prices and everything that are **included** and **excluded** (page 5).
- We do **NOT** share our routes, activities and or accommodation details.
- For the **3-4 day tours** of the **8 hours** tour days, **4 hours** will be spent on the Jeep. While for the **5-6 day tours** some days will be **5-6 hours**.
- Packing list, weather, other infor (page 8).
- Please ensure you have **read our T&C** before booking.
- Bookings require a **deposit** - we do not reserve places without!

Whilst it is not possible to see the whole loop in just 3 days, we have crafted an itinerary designed to show you the best of the loop. In 3 days you'll see around 70% of the loop, some hidden gems, backroads and trails. Waterfalls, caves, swimming holes and remote highland villages.

Just some of the route highlights...

Quan Ba, Tham Ma, Can Ty, Bac Sum & Chin Khoanh Passes - Legendary mountain roads with incredible panoramic views.

Pho Bang Ancient Town - A minority village near the Chinese border, known for houses made entirely out of clay.

Lao Xa Silversmith Village - A very remote Hmong village high in the mountains. Their craft of silver has been kept alive and passed down for generations.

Hmong King's Palace - 100 year old mansion of the former Hmong Royal Family.

Ma Pi Leng Pass, Nho Que River and Tu San Canyon - The most breathtaking views and surreal boat ride through the canyon.

Lung Tam Linen Cooperative - A traditional weaving workshop making clothing and goods from hemp.

Dong Van Karst Plateau - A UNESCO geo-park, featuring unique rock formations.





4 DAY / 3 NIGHTS TOUR



Our 4 day tour covers everything on our 3 day, however, we take a totally different route.

The extra day means you'll see 100% of the loop and some!!!

The 4 day tour allows for a more complete experience; it allows us more time to take you further off the beaten track. Smaller, longer trails with even more hidden gems along the way.

Additional highlights...

North Dong Van Loop - Rice terraces, cliffside roads and panoramic views into China.

Yen Minh Pine Forests and Town - Nestled on high ground, with a cool and relaxed vibe.

Lung Cu Flag Tower - Vietnam's most Northern point, climb the tower for the 360 views.

Lo Lo Chai Cultural Village - Home to the Lo Lo minority, a community of just 120 families.

Sao Ha - Deep valleys covered with shades of green, layered mountain peaks with endless views!

5 DAY / 4 NIGHTS TOUR HA GIANG & NA HANG

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With our 5 day tour, we take you far beyond the busyness of the main loop, venturing south to Na Hang Lake and away from the crowds - while still taking in the best of the loop along the way. It's the perfect combination of Ha Giang's best-known sights and its most remote corners.

Just some of the route highlights...

Ma Pi Leng Pass - The most famous pass in Ha Giang, known as the "King of the passes"

Si Lau Phin Village - A rarely visited ethnic village, deep in the mountains, well away from civilisation.

Pho Bang Ancient Town - A traditional ethnic village near the Chinese border, famed for its clay houses.

Quiet Backroads back to Ha Giang - Return to Ha Giang city from the south through small villages other tours don't explore

Na Hang Lake - An 80sq km lake surrounded by limestone mountains. Boat out to the Sky Buffalo Tying Column, a 50m high stone tower rising from the water.

Secret Waterfall - Visit our secret waterfall hidden near Na Hang Lake to relax and swim.



6 DAY / 5 NIGHTS TOUR HA GIANG, NA HANG & CAO BANG

The 6 day tour is the ultimate Ha Giang and Cao Bang loop - 6 full days exploring the famous Ha Giang loop, the stunning Cao Bang region, and the remote Na Hang Lake. This is your chance to discover not just the real Ha Giang, but the real Northern Vietnam, far away from the other tourists.

Additional highlights...

Hong Thai Ricefields - High-altitude terraced rice fields (over 1,200m) in a remote Dao Tien village, glowing gold at harvest time (Sept/Oct) or mirror-like when flooded in spring.

Ma Pi Leng & Khau Coc Cha Pass - As well as the famous Ma Pi Leng Pass, ride the Khau Coc Cha - the most stunning pass in Cao Bang.

Ban Gioc Waterfall and Tiger Cave - Visit Vietnam's most iconic waterfall, right on the border with China and the nearby cave.

Cao Bang Traditional Villages - Explore traditional villages in Cao Bang, including blacksmith, papermaking and incense-making communities.

God's Eye Mountain - The famous mountain with a hole through it, set in a spectacular plateau surrounded by karst mountains.

Na Hang Lake & Sectet waterfall - An 80sq km lake surrounded by limestone mountains. Boat out to the 50m high stone tower rising from the water, as well as visit a secret waterfall.

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ESSENTIALS: Local fully licensed Jeep driver.

Modern comfortable Open Top Jeep with the option for a cover.
You can sit and stand in the Jeep using the padded bar to lean.

All activity costs and entrance fees.

Drinking water throughout the day

Start the tour with a cooler full of cold drinks to take with you.

Luggage storage

ONE WAY BUS TICKET: A one way bus ticket between Hanoi & Ha Giang is included for each person on the tour.

FOOD & DRINK: 3 meals a day - we can accomodate your dietary requirements, just notify us in advance. Excludes dinner on the final night.

ACCOMMODATION: Private room available for each person. Solo or shared with your group.

SPRING

March - April: Cool / mild and dry.

SUMMER

May: Temperatures start to reach high 30's.

June - September: Hottest time of year and rainy season. Most rain is at night but there can be short, heavy downpours.

AUTUMN

October - November: Cool / mild and dry

WINTER

December - February: Dry but can get very cold, especially at night

PACKING LIST

All year round: Rain gear , decent footwear.

Summer: Long tops and trousers (cover from the sun), factor 50 sunscreen, sunglasses, swimwear.

Spring & Autumn: Some warm clothes for evenings plus the above.

Winter: Warm clothes, thick coat and multiple layers, gloves, scarf etc.

You can still get cold when you are standing in the Jeep.

MISC

There is very **good internet** service almost everywhere throughout the region.

Free WIFI is very common in homestays, cafes and restaurants.

ATMs are almost common but charge a fee and have low limits.

It is recommended to bring cash from Hanoi beforehand. **VP Bank** has a large limit and little or no fee.



Terms and Conditions

DEPOSIT

An deposit of 20% of the total tour cost is required, this is held in escrow until full payment is received.

The deposit can be returned in full or deducted upon full payment.

PAYMENT

Full payment is required prior to the tour starting. Prices and payment can be converted at live Google exchange rate. We accept clean, undamaged, USD, EUR, GBP, AUD and VND cash. Bank transfer in VND or credit/debit card payments but with 5% fee.

HA GIANG BORDER REGION PERMIT

All Foreign Nationals wishing to visit Ha Giang require a border region permit. We can also apply for you or you can get this yourself but this needs to be done in advance if you do it yourself and in Ha Giang. The permit costs 260k VND. Failure to obtain a permit can result in a fine of upto 2mil VND.

FORCE MAJEURE

In the event that we cancel the tour due to unforeseen events (natural disasters, acts of war, national strikes etc). We will fully refund your deposit. Any other consequential costs will be borne by you.

INSURANCE

We highly recommend you obtain your own personal travel insurance for the tour.

TRANSPORTATION

We can arrange transport to and from Ha Giang, however, we are not the transport operators thus any claims arising from such must be taken directly to the transport provider.

RIGHT OF REFUSAL

We reserve the right to decline our services to anyone without reason or justification. If you have a confirmed booking, we will inform you and fully refund your deposit. This includes after the tour has started.

INDEMNIFICATION

You understand and accept this activity involves inherent risks and that you have no grounds to hold "Style Motorbikes" responsible for any personal or third party claims which may arise from your participation in our tours.

CANCELLATION

If the booking is cancelled after the booking is made then the deposit is forfeited.
